ABBOTT, TONY. *The Hidden Stairs and the Magic Carpet.*

[Secrets of Droon #1] [J PBK]

After entering the tiny room underneath the stairs, three friends find themselves in a magic world of shiny red men and flying lizards, and they are soon forced to face great challenges in order to survive and make their way back home

ALEXANDER, LLOYD. *Wizard in the Tree.* [J FIC]

Mallory's encounter with the wizard in the tree begins a chain of events that change the lives of the villagers dominated by a suspicious squire.

***The Book of Three.* [The Prydain Chronicles #1] [J FIC]**

In the imaginary kingdom of Prydain, lives an Assistant Pigkeeper who sets out questing for knightly adventure with the hope of becoming a knightly hero.

ANDERSON, JANET. *Going Through the Gate.* [J FIC]

The five sixth-grade students in a small town prepare for their teacher's annual graduation ceremony, a mysterious ritual that several generations of students have experienced but no one can discuss.

BARRON, T. A. *Child of the Dark Prophecy.* [The Great Tree of Avalon #1] [YA FIC]

In accordance with prophecy, Avalon's existence is threatened in the year that stars stop shining and at the time when both the dark child and Merlin's heir are to be revealed.

BELLAIRS, JOHN. *The Dark Secret of Weatherend.* [J FIC]

Fourteen-year-old Anthony Monday of Hoosac, Minnesota, and his friend Miss Eells, the Hoosac librarian, try to stop an evil wizard from turning the world into an icy wasteland.

BLACK, HOLLY. *The Field Guide.* [The Spiderwick Chronicles #1] [J FIC]

When the Grace children go to stay at their Great Aunt Lucinda's worn Victorian house, they discover a field guide to fairies and other creatures and begin to have some unusual experiences.

BRENNAN, HERBIE. *Faerie Wars.* [YA FIC]

Troubled by family problems, Henry finds his life taking a whole new dimension when he and his friend, old Mr. Fogarty, become involved with Prince Pyrgus Malvae who has been sent from the faerie world in order to escape the treacherous Faeries of the Night.

BRITAIN, BILL. *The Mystery of the Several Sevens.* [J FIC]

Mr. Merlin, a wizard disguised as a substitute teacher, magically transports two fifth graders to a fairyland where they must solve a riddle to find out who has stolen the seven dwarfs' bag of diamonds.

CARMAN, PATRICK. *The Dark Hills Divide.* [The Land of Elyon #1] [J FIC]

When she finds the key to a secret passageway leading out of the walled city of Bridewell, twelve-year-old Alexa realizes her lifelong wish to explore the mysterious forests and mountains that lie beyond the wall.

CARROLL, LEWIS. *Alice's Adventures in Wonderland.* [J FIC]

A little girl falls down a rabbit hole and discovers a world of nonsensical and amusing characters.

CHRISTENSEN, JAMES. *Voyage of the Basset.* [J FIC]

In 1850, with the importance of myths in question, Professor Aisling and his two young daughters set out from London on a journey aboard a magical ship and encounter an assortment of characters who prove the power of stories.

CHETWIN, GRACE. *The Riddle & the Rune.* [J FIC]

Gom sets forth to seek his destiny, discovering that he has new powers and a gift for making friends such as the magnificent horse, Stormfleet, who accompanies him through many adventures.

COLFER, EOIN. *Artemis Fowl.* [YA FIC]

[*Sequels: Arctic Incident and Eternity Code*]

When a twelve-year-old evil genius tries to restore his family fortune by capturing a fairy and demanding a ransom in gold, the fairies fight back with magic, technology, and a particularly nasty troll.

COLLINS, SUZANNE. *Gregor the Overlander.*

[*The Underland Chronicles #1*] [J FIC]

When eleven-year-old Gregor and his two-year-old sister are pulled into a strange underground world, they trigger an epic battle involving men, bats, rats, cockroaches, and spiders while on a quest foretold by ancient prophecy.

COOPER, SUSAN. *The Boggart.* [J FIC]

After visiting the castle in Scotland which her family has inherited and returning home to Canada, twelve-year-old Emily finds that she has accidentally brought back with her a boggart, an invisible and mischievous spirit with a fondness for practical jokes.

***Over Sea, Under Stone.* [The Dark is Rising #1] [J FIC & YA FIC]**

Three children on a holiday in Cornwall find an ancient manuscript which sends them on a dangerous quest for a grail that would reveal the true story of King Arthur.

COVILLE, BRUCE. *Into the Land of Unicorns.*

[*The Unicorn Chronicles #1*] [J FIC]

Having jumped into the fantasy land of Luster, Cara joins Lightfoot the unicorn in the search for Queen Arabella Skydancer.

***Jeremy Thatcher, Dragon Hatcher.* [J FIC]**

Small for his age but artistically talented, twelve-year-old Jeremy Thatcher unknowingly buys a dragon's egg.

DAHL, ROALD. *Matilda.* [J FIC]

Matilda applies her untapped mental powers to rid the school of the evil, child-hating headmistress, Miss Trunchbull, and restore her nice teacher, Miss Honey, to financial security.

***The Witches.* [J FIC]**

A young boy and his Norwegian grandmother, who is an expert on witches, together foil a witch's plot to destroy the world's children by turning them into mice.

DE ANGELI, MARGUERITE. *The Door in the Wall.* [J FIC]

Robin, a cripple, is taken by Brother Luke to a monastery, where he learns to read, write, carve and use crutches. Together they journey to the castle on the Welsh marshes where he becomes a page and eventually wins his Knighthood by an act of bravery.

DUANE, DIANE. *So You Want to Be a Wizard?* [Young Wizards #1] [J FIC]

Thirteen-year-old Nita, tormented by a gang of bullies because she won't fight back, finds the help she needs in a library book on wizardry which guides her into another dimension.

EAGER, EDWARD. *Half Magic.* [Magic Series #1] [J FIC]

Four children looking forward to an ordinary summer enjoy a series of fantastic adventures by double-wishing on an ancient coin.

FISHER, CATHERINE. *Snow-Walker.* [The Snow-Walker's Son Trilogy #1] [YA FIC]

The snow-walker Gudrun came from the swirling mists and icy depths beyond the edge of the world to rule the Jarl's people with fear and sorcery, but a small band of outlaws will fight to the death to restore the land to its rightful leader.

FLETCHER, SUSAN. *Dragon's Milk.* [Dragon Chronicles #1] [J FIC]

Kaeldra, an outsider adopted by an Elythian family as a baby, possesses the power to understand dragons and uses this power to try to save her younger sister, who needs dragon's milk to recover from an illness.

FUNKE, CORNELIA. *Dragon Rider.* [J FIC]

After learning that humans are headed toward his hidden home, Firedrake, a silver dragon, is joined by a brownie and an orphan boy in a quest to find the legendary valley known as the Rim of Heaven, encountering friendly and unfriendly creatures along the way, and struggling to evade the relentless pursuit of an old enemy.

GLIORI, DEBI. *Pure Dead Magic.* [Pure Dead Magic #1] [J FIC]

When their father is kidnapped and danger looms, the Strega-Borgia children, their mysterious new nanny, and a giant tarantula use magic and actual trips through the Internet to bring peace to their Scottish castle.

HADDIX, MARGARET. *Just Ella.* [YA FIC]

In this continuation of the Cinderella story, fifteen-year-old Ella finds that accepting Prince Charming's proposal ensnares her in a suffocating tangle of palace rules and royal etiquette, so she plots to escape.

IBBOTSON, EVA. *Secret of Platform 13.* [J FIC]

Edge Gribble, a young hag, accompanies an old wizard, a gentle fey, and a giant ogre on their mission through a magical tunnel from their Island to London to rescue their King and Queen's son who had been stolen as an infant.

***Which Witch.* [J FIC]**

Deciding that he must sire a child to carry on his tradition of Loathing Light and Blighting the Beautiful, the Great Wizard Arriman announces a competition among the witches of Todcaster, one of whom will marry him.

JACQUES, BRIAN. *Redwall.* [Redwall #1] [J FIC]

When the peaceful life of ancient Redwall Abbey is shattered by the arrival of the evil rat Cluny and his villainous hordes, Matthias, a young mouse, determines to find the legendary sword of Martin the Warrior which, he is convinced, will help Redwall's inhabitants destroy the enemy.

JONES, DIANA WYNNE. *Dark Lord of Derkholm.* [Sequel: *Year of the Griffin*] [YA FIC]

Derk, an unconventional wizard, and his magical family become involved in a plan to put a stop to the devastating tours of their world arranged by the tyrannical Mr. Chesney.

***The Merlin Conspiracy.* [YA FIC]**

Roddy and Nick, two teenagers with magical powers they are just learning to use, find that they must work together to save Roddy's home world of Blest from destruction by power-hungry wizards.

***Wild Robert.* [J FIC]**

While trying to get away from the tourists visiting the stately home where her parents are caretakers, Heather accidentally summons a mischievous 350-year-old youth with magical powers and nothing is ever the same again.

JUSTER, NORTON. *The Phantom Tollbooth.* [J FIC]

A journey through a land where Milo learns the importance of words and numbers provide a cure for his boredom.

KERR, PHILIP. *The Akhenaten Adventure.* [Children of the Lamp #1] [J FIC]

When twelve-year-old twins Philippa and John discover that they are descended from a long line of djinn, their mother sends them away to their Uncle Nimrod, who takes them to Cairo where he starts to teach them about their extraordinary powers.

LE GUIN, URSULA K. *A Wizard of Earthsea.* [Earthsea Tetology #1] [YA FIC]

A boy grows to manhood while attempting to subdue the evil he unleashed on the world as an apprentice to the Master Wizard.

L'ENGLE, MADELINE. *Wrinkle in Time.* [Sequel: *A Wind in the Door.*]
[J FIC]

The story of the adventures in space and time of Meg, Charles Wallace, and Calvin O'Keefe (athlete, student, and one of the most popular boys in high school). They are in search of Meg's father, a scientist who disappeared while engaged in secret work for the government on the tesseract problem. "A tesseract (in case the reader doesn't know) is a wrinkle in time."

LEVINE, GAIL CARSON. *Ella Enchanted.* [J FIC]

In this novel based on the story of Cinderella, Ella struggles against the childhood curse that forces her to obey any order given to her.

LEWIS, C. S. *The Magician's Nephew.* [Chronicles of Narnia #1]
[J FIC]

When Digory and Polly try to return the wicked witch Jadis to her own world, the magic gets mixed up and they all land in Narnia where they witness Aslan blessing the animals with human speech.

LOWRY, LOIS. *The Giver.* [J FIC]

Given his lifetime assignment at the Ceremony of Twelve, Jonas becomes the receiver of memories shared by only one other in his community and discovers the terrible truth about the society in which he lives. [Sequels: *Gathering Blue* and *Messenger.*]

McGRAW, ELOISE. *The Moorchild* [J FIC]

Feeling that she is neither fully human nor "Folk," a changeling learns her true identity and attempts to find the human child whose place she had been given.

McKINLEY, ROBIN. *The Blue Sword.* [YA FIC]

Harry, bored with her sheltered life in the remote orange-growing colony of Daria, discovers magic in herself when she is kidnapped by a native king with mysterious powers.

Spindle's End. [YA FIC]

The infant princess Briar Rose is cursed on her name day by Pernicia, an evil fairy, and then whisked away by a young fairy to be raised in a remote part of a magical country, unaware of her real identity and hidden from Pernicia's vengeful powers.

McMULLEN, K. A. *The New Kid at School.* [Dragonslayers Academy #1]
[J PBK FIC]

Wiglaf is off to Dragon Slayers Academy and in for a first day of school he will never forget.

NESBIT, EDITH *The Enchanted Castle.* [J FIC]

Four English children find a wonderful world of magic through an enchanted wishing ring.

The Story of the Amulet. [J PBK FIC]

Four brothers and sisters find half an amulet and, while searching for the other half, travel back in time.

NICHOLSON, WILLIAM. *The Wind Singer.* [Wind on Fire #1] [J FIC]

After Kestrel Hath rebels against the stifling rules of Aramant society and is forced to flee, she, along with her twin brother and a tagalong classmate, follow an ancient map in quest of the legendary silver voice of the wind singer, in an attempt to heal Aramant and its people.

NIMMO, JENNY. *Midnight for Charlie Bone.* [Children of the Red King #1] [J FIC]

Charlie Bone's life with his widowed mother and two grandmothers undergoes a dramatic change when he discovers that he can hear people in photographs talking.

NIX, GARTH. *The Fall.* [The Seventh Tower #1] [J PBK FIC]

After Tal's father disappears with the family's Sunstone, Tal tries to find a way to get a new one and cure his ailing mother.

Mister Monday. [The Keys to the Kingdom #1] [J PBK FIC]

Arthur's life is saved by a key shaped like the minute hand of a clock, but bizarre creatures from another realm are determined to take the key even if it means killing him.

NORTON, MARY. *Bed-Knob and Broomstick.* [J FIC]

With the powers they acquire from a spinster who is studying to be a witch, three children go on a number of exciting and gruesome trip

PAOLINI, CHRISTOPHER. *Eragon.* [Inheritance #1] [YA FIC]

In Alagaesia, a fifteen-year-old boy of unknown lineage called Eragon finds a mysterious stone that weaves his life into an intricate tapestry of destiny, magic, and power, peopled with dragons, elves, and monsters.

PATTOU, EDITH. *Hero's Song.* [Song of Eirren #1] [YA FIC]

On a quest to rescue his kidnapped sister, Collun discovers that he is a key figure in the struggle to save the kingdom of Eirren from conquest by Medb, the Queen of Ghosts.

PEARCE, PHILIPPA. *Tom's Midnight Garden.* [J FIC]

Tom finds himself in the midst of a strange adventure involving a garden that appears only at night and a girl from another time.

PIERCE, MEREDITH. *The Dark-angel.* [The Darkangel Trilogy #1] [YA FIC]

The servant girl Aerial must choose between destroying her vampire master for his evil deeds or saving him for the sake of his beauty and the spark of greatness she has seen in him.

PEEL, JOHN. *Book of Names.* [The Diadem #1] [J PBK FIC]

Three teenagers from very different worlds--Score, a streetwise New Yorker; Renald, who prepares for a medieval battle; and Pixel, who is confined to the one-room world of Virtual

Reality--are kidnapped and plunged into a perilous odyssey as they seek to unlock the secrets of the Diadem.

PIERCE, TAMORA. *Magic Steps.* [The Circle Opens #1] [YA PBK]

When drawn into the investigation of murders perpetrated on a powerful family in Summersea, Sandy and her student Pasco undertake the dangerous mission of entrapping the invisible killers.

***Wild Magic.* [The Immortals #1] [YA FIC & YA PBK]**

The mage Numair, the knight Alanna, and Queen Thayet enlist thirteen-year-old Daine's help to battle the dreadful immortal creatures that have recently begun to attack the kingdom of Tortall.

PULLMAN, PHILIP. *The Golden Compass.* [His Dark Materials #1] [J FIC & YA FIC]

Accompanied by her daemon, Lyra Belacqua sets out to prevent her best friend and other kidnapped children from becoming the subject of gruesome experiments in the Far North.

REGAN, DIAN CURTIS. *Princess Nevermore.* [YA FIC]

When a fifteen-year-old Mandrian princess makes a wish in a wizard's circle, she winds up on Earth alone and without the ability and desire to return to home.

RODDA, EMILY. *Rowan of Rin.* [Rowan of Rin #1] [J FIC]

Because only he can read the magical map, young, weak, and timid Rowan joins six other villagers to climb a mountain and try to restore their water supply, as fears of a dragon and other horrors threaten to drive them back.

SCIESZKA, JON. *Knights of the Kitchen Table.* [The Time Warp Trio #1] [J FIC]

Joe receives a magic book for his birthday present from his uncle. Joe, Fred and Sam are transported to a time when evil knights, fire-breathing dragons and vile-smelling giants roamed the land.

SNICKET, LEMONY. *The Bad Beginning.* [The Series of Unfortunate Events #1] [J FIC]

After the sudden death of their parents, the three Baudelaire children must depend on each other and their wits when it turns out that the distant relative who is appointed their guardian is determined to use any means necessary to get their fortune.

STEWART, PAUL. *Beyond the Deepwoods.* [The Edge Chronicles #1] [J FIC]

Thirteen-year-old Twig, having always looked and felt different from his woodtroll family, learns that he is adopted and travels out of his Deepwoods home to find the place where he belongs.

THOMPSON, KATE. *Switchers.* [Sequel: *Midnight's Choice*] [J FIC]

When freakish weather grips the Arctic regions and moves southward, an Irish girl and her strange companion save the world from disaster through their ability to switch into animal forms.

TOLKIEN, J. R. R. *The Hobbit, or, There and Back Again.*

Bilbo Baggins, a respectable, well-to-do hobbit, lives comfortably in his hobbit-hole until the day the wandering wizard Gandalf chooses him to share in an adventure from which he may never return.

The Fellowship of the Ring. [The Lord of the Rings Part 1] [ADULT FIC]

Frodo the hobbit and his companions set out to deliver the One Ring of Power to the dark land of Mordor in order to destroy the ring in the forge of its creation.

WHITE, T.H. *The Sword in the Stone.* [J FIC]

A retelling of the Arthurian legend.

WELLS, H. G. *The Time Machine.* [J FIC & ADULT FIC]

A scientist invents a machine that transports him far into the future where he discovers a changed world inhabited by two unusual races, the Eloi and the Morlocks.

WINTHROP, ELIZABETH. *The Castle in the Attic.* [Sequel: *Battle for the Castle*] [J FIC]

A gift of a toy castle, complete with silver knight, introduces William to an adventure involving magic and a personal quest.

WREDE, PATRICIA. *Dealing with Dragons.* [The Enchanted Forest Chronicles #1] [YA FIC]

Bored with traditional palace life, a princess goes off to live with a group of dragons and soon becomes involved with fighting against some disreputable wizards who want to steal away the dragons' kingdom.

YEP, LAWRENCE. *The Tiger's Apprentice.* [The Tiger's Apprentice #1] [YA FIC]

A tiger, a monkey, a dragon, and a twelve-year-old Chinese American boy fight to keep a magic talisman out of the hands of an enemy who would use its power to destroy the world.

Sequel: *Tiger's Blood.*

YOLEN, JANE. *Passager* [The Young Merlin Trilogy, # 1] [J FIC]

A foundling rediscovers his identity through the help of the falconer who adopts him.

Includes children's letters about why they love the Harry Potter books.
