

How to register your bike with the Portsmouth Police Department

Registering your bike with the Portsmouth Police is a simple process.

- **Bring your bike to the Portsmouth Police Department.**

- *See the Station Officer at the front entrance.*

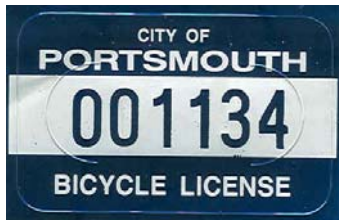
- **Ask to have bike registered.**

- Fill out the form the officer gives you and pay .50 cents to pay for the processing of your bike info into the Portsmouth Police Computers.

- **Attach the numbered sticker you get from the Portsmouth**

Police to the frame of the bike near the rear deflector (make sure it goes on a part of the bike that cannot be removed like the frame).
