Reference: Drug Arrests and Wanted Subject

On Tuesday, June 22, 2010, Detectives Robert Munson and Aaron Goodwin arrested Katherine Stringer for Sale of a Controlled Drug, Oxycontin, to an undercover police officer. The offense occurred in the Holiday Drive - Wamesit neighborhood.

Ms. Stringer was released on \$2,500 PR bail and is due back in the Portsmouth District Court for her arraignment on August 2, 2010.

On the same day, Detectives filed a detainer letter with the Belknap County Department of Corrections for an inmate of theirs, Anthony DelRossi. Mr. DelRossi has an active warrant for Conspiracy to Commit, a felony level crime. The complaint alleges that Mr. DelRossi with a purpose to commit the crime of Sale of a Controlled Drug, negotiated a drug deal involving Katherine Stringer. The letter of detainer will serve to prevent Mr. DelRossi from being released from Jail, and will allow Detectives to arrest him.
