**Seacoast Wiffleball Challenge:** The following is a basic set of rules that will govern the tournament. A complete list of rules will be given out on game day.

## Basic Rules

1. No base running
2. A swing and a miss is an out
3. Any combination of two strikes is an out
4. Three outs per inning
5. Home runs are over the fence
6. Triples are off the fence
7. Doubles are balls that travel in the air past the designated doubles line
8. Singles are anything that goes beyond the singles line.
9. Ground balls that are fielded cleanly are outs. And pop flies and line drives that are caught are outs.
10. 6 innings per game. If the game is tied the eighth inning starts with the bases loaded
11. Only regulation wiffleballs and bats are permitted
12. Maximum of 3 players in the field at once
13. Teams consist of 1 to 5 players
14. Tag Rule: If there is a runner on third and less than 2 outs, then batting team can call tag while the ball is in the air. The fielding player will then have to throw the ball and hit the strike zone for the runner to be out. If the ball does not hit the strike zone the runner is safe at home.
15. Lines will be drawn on the field to designate singles and doubles and foul territory.
16. Pitch speed is medium
