

City Charter Advisory Committee Information:

Mayor Ferrini and the City Council voted to appoint a City Charter Advisory Committee with the following charge:

The City Charter Advisory Committee (CCAC) shall be charged with determining public interest in potential changes to the City Charter and with presenting to the City Council such proposed changes arising from public interest. The CCAC shall hold at least one public hearing regarding proposed changes at the beginning of their deliberations and at least one public hearing at the end of their deliberations after a report out of their findings and/or recommendations, if any. The Committee shall sunset on June 30th with a report back to the City Council.

The City Charter Advisory Committee will conduct a public hearing on Thursday, March 10th at 7:00 p.m. in the Eileen Dondero Foley Council Chambers – Municipal Complex at 7:00 p.m. The purpose of the public hearing will be to ascertain any public concerns with any provision of the City Charter.
