

CITY COUNCIL MCINTYRE SUBCOMMITTEE MINUTES APRIL 19, 2021 MEETING

The McIntyre Subcommittee held the April 19, 2021 meeting via Zoom.

Chair Peter Whelan opened the meeting at 2:02 with a roll call.

<u>Present via Zoom</u>: Chair Peter Whelan and Councilors Deaglan McEachern, John Tabor and Paige Trace.

<u>City representatives present via Zoom</u>: City Manager Karen Conard, City Attorney Robert Sullivan, Principal Planner Nick Cracknell, Moderator Synthia Ravell and Legal Secretary Marian Steimke

Also present via Zoom: Russell Preston and Mandy Reynolds, both of Principle Group (PG)

<u>Public comment</u>: Seeing no one that wished to speak, Chair Whelan closed public comment at 2:03.

Those present discussed the schedule for the April 20, 2021 public meeting for which Mr. Preston organized a forum to encourage dialogue. He said the plan was to discuss survey results from the second round table, go into breakout rooms and come back to the forum as a group to go through it all including Q&A. He estimated 1.5-2 hours to complete. The headcount was 158 at the time of the meeting.

Those present discussed using input platforms rather than verbal report back due to the large number of people. They discussed feedback methods to ensure accuracy and to ensure they get all the comments back.

Councilor McEachern moved to enter nonpublic session pursuant to RSA 91-A:3II(e). Councilor Trace seconded the motion. On a 4-0 roll call vote, the motion passed at 2:10 p.m.

Councilor McEachern left the meeting at 3:35 p.m. for another meeting.

No motions were made and no actions taken.

Councilor Trace moved to enter public session, seal the minutes of the nonpublic session and adjourn the meeting. Councilor Tabor seconded. On a roll call vote 3-0, the motion passed at 3:52 pm
