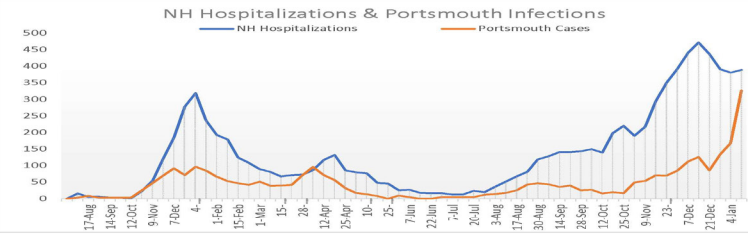

Race/Ethnicity is known for 69.2% of COVID-19 infections, 0.0% of hospitalizations, and 92.9% of deaths.

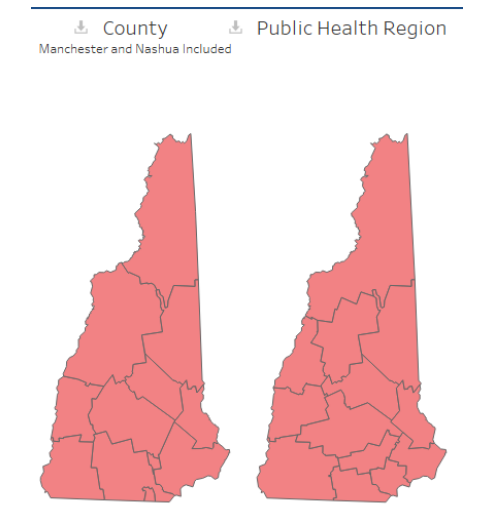
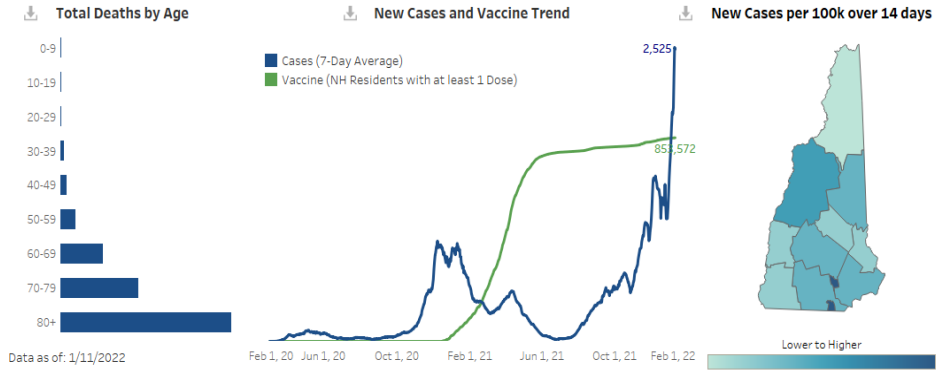
Graphs above and below right show trends in hospitalizations as medical experts say this is the best indicator of COVID-19 severity from the Omicron variant.



New Hampshire announced **1,627 cases** for January 11. There were an average of **2,525 cases per day** over the most recent 7-day period (January 5 to January 11). This is a **46% increase** compared to the previous 7-day period.
