Good Morning.





I'm reaching out regarding parking on Daniel Street. I have been running Moe's Italian Sandwiches for more than 25 years now, but my family business has been on Daniel Street for 63 years. Being a small business in an everchanging city, we have faced our share of challenges, but the 1-2 punch of Covid 19 and the Brick Market construction has quite possibly been the worst. Today I learned that the three 15 minute parking spaces (two in front of Moe's and one directly across the street) are being moved in front of the brick market. Please understand that for 2 years, our customers have gotten used to parking out front in a 15 minute spot and running in to pick up an order. We even run out pre-paid orders to customers that may have kids in the car or are unable to come in for health reasons. It is a service to our customers and the Portsmouth community that we will not be able to do with 3 hour parking out front. Making this change with less than a week's notice during our busiest month of the year is unfair to our customers and detrimental to our business. I am requesting that the 2 fifteen minute spaces (or at least 1) be kept in front of Moe's. Almost every other food business in town has outdoor dining but we did not apply for that because the parking is so important to our "all take out" business. I am hoping you will see the value in keeping a 63 year old Portsmouth business alive and successful in the "New Portsmouth".
