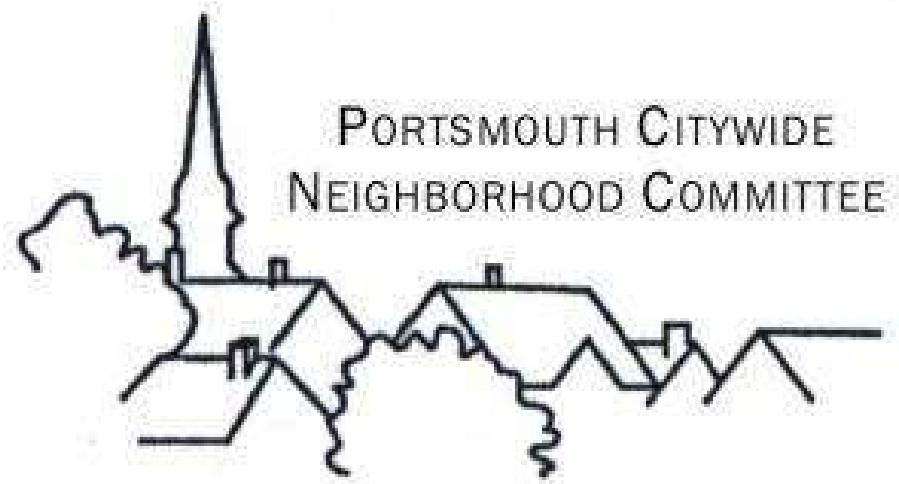
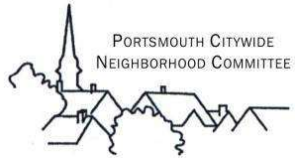

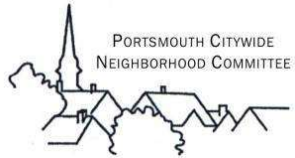




# About CNC

- Appointed by Mayor Eileen Foley
- Mayoral Blue-Ribbon Committee

  - Today: 16 active associations



## About CNC (cont'd)

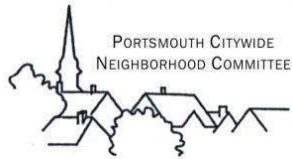
### Mission Statement:

and

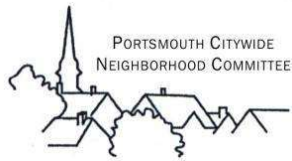
2) preservation of the quality of our neighborhoods.

- Participation since the 90s

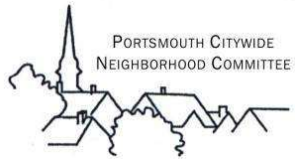

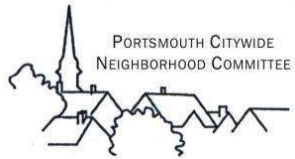

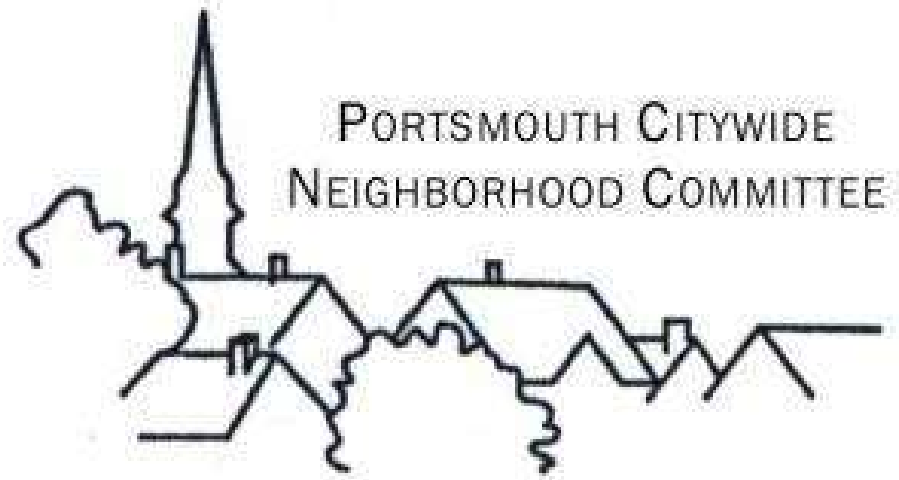
