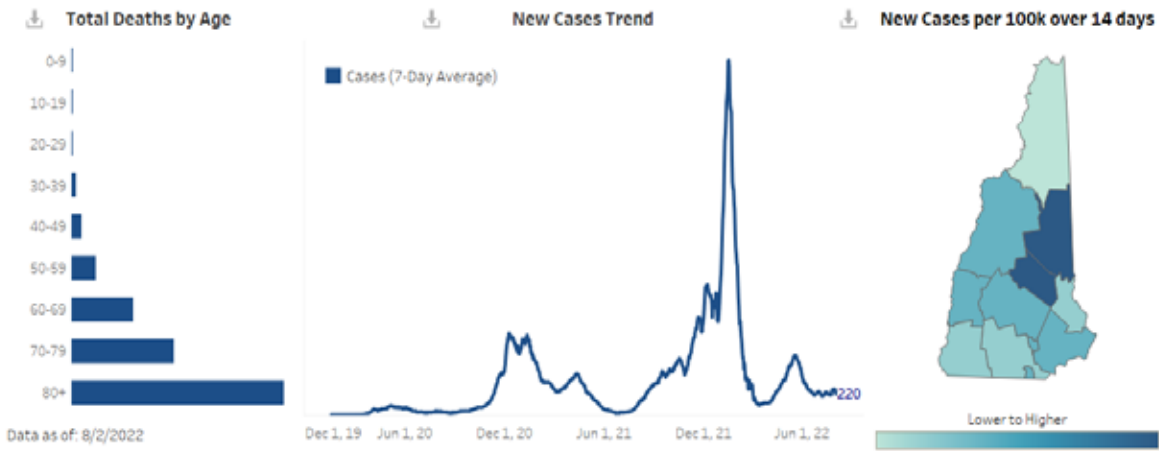


COVID-19 BULLETIN BOARD 8/3/22

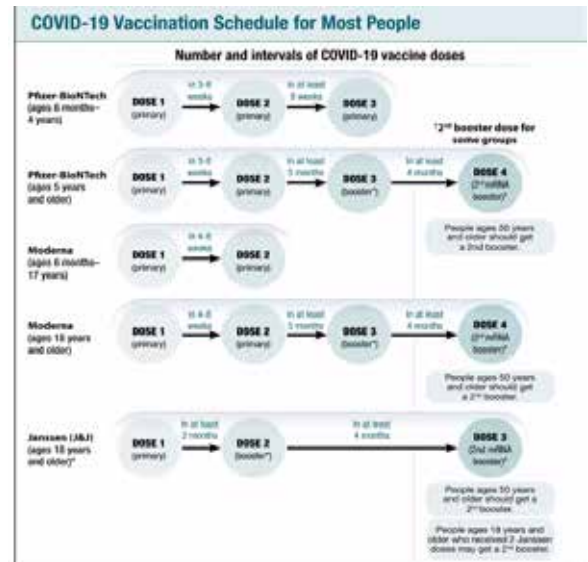


NHDHHS is reporting a 14% decrease in the number of cases for the 7 days ending August 2 compared to the previous 7 days. CDC is classifying Rockingham County (map below) as “low risk” for community infection.

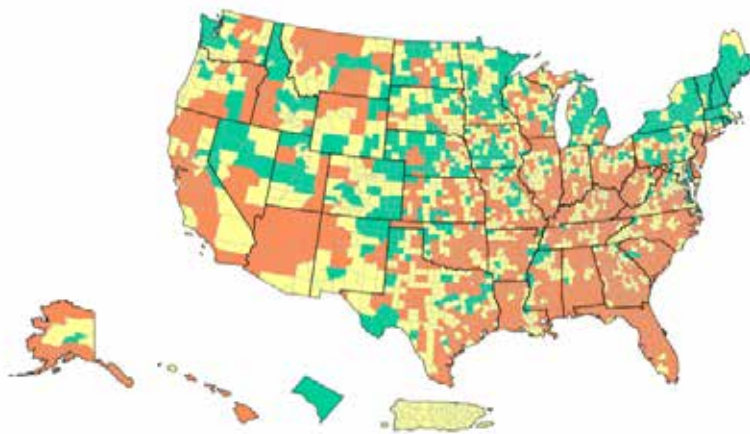
