VOTER REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS

- ◇ 18 YEARS OF AGE OR WILL BE 18 PRIOR TO ELECTION DATE
- ◇ PHOTO IDENTIFICATION
- ◇ A BIRTH CERTIFICATE OR A U.S. PASSPORT, OR U.S. MILITARY IDENTIFICATION
- ◇ MUST BE A U.S. CITIZEN/NATURALIZED CITIZEN
IF NOT BORN IN U.S. WILL NEED TO SHOW U.S. PASSPORT AND/OR NATURALIZATION DOCUMENTATION.
- ◇ PROOF OF RESIDENCY (PORTSMOUTH PHYSICAL ADDRESS)

BIENNIALLY, ON THE ODD NUMBER OF YEARS, THE CITY OF PORTSMOUTH HOLDS AN ELECTION TO ELECT ITS GOVERNING BODIES SUCH AS:

ELECTION INFORMATION

THE CITY COUNCIL IS ELECTED AT-LARGE. WHEREAS THE CANDIDATE RECEIVING THE HIGHEST NUMBER OF VOTES WILL BE ELECTED AS MAYOR OF PORTSMOUTH.

THE CANDIDATE RECEIVING THE SECOND HIGHEST NUMBER OF VOTES WILL BE ELECTED AS ASSISTANT MAYOR OF PORTSMOUTH.
