- ♦ 18 YEARS OF AGE OR WILL BE 18 PRIOR TO ELECTION DATE
- ♦ PHOTO IDENTIFICATION
- ♦ A BIRTH CERTIFICATE OR A U.S. PASSPORT, OR U.S. MILITARY IDENTIFICATION
- Must be a U.S. Citizen/Naturalized Citizen

 IF NOT BORN IN U.S. WILL NEED TO SHOW U.S. Passport and/or naturalization

 Documentation.
- PROOF OF RESIDENCY
 (PORTSMOUTH PHYSICAL ADDRESS)
