AN ACT relative to the board of directors of the Pease development authority.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1 1 Board of Directors: Pease Development Authority. Amend RSA 12-G:4, I to read as follows: $\mathbf{2}$ I. The management of the authority shall be vested in a board of 7 directors to be appointed 3 as follows: 4(a) One member appointed by the governor and executive council. $\mathbf{5}$ (b) One member appointed by the [mayor and city council of] governor and executive 6 council and from the city of Portsmouth. 7(c) One member appointed by the [board of selectmen of] governor and executive 8 council and from the town of Newington. 9 (d) One member appointed by the president of the senate. 10(e) One member appointed by the speaker of the house of representatives. 11 (f) One member appointed jointly by the board of selectmen of the town of Greenland 12and the board of selectmen of the town of Newington] by the governor and executive council and 13from one of the towns of Greenland, Rye, or New Castle. 14(g) One member who is nominated by majority vote of the legislative delegation of 15Strafford county, including the senators whose districts include towns in Strafford county, and who 16is appointed by the governor, the senate president, and the speaker of the house. The member 17appointed in this manner shall be a resident of Strafford county and shall serve an initial term of 2 18years beginning June 1, 1993. Subsequent terms shall be governed by the provisions of this section. 19The member appointed in this manner may be removed from office for cause after hearing by the 20Strafford county legislative delegation. 212 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
